REQUEST FOR BID

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District is seeking sealed bids from machinery suppliers for a trailer-mounted vacuum pump. Sealed bids must be received by 10:00 A.M on Tuesday, June 24, 2008. The bid price quoted must be good for 45 days therefrom.

The specifications for the trailer-mounted vacuum pump are shown in Attachment "A". The vacuum pump shall be a RAMVAC 2000 or functionally similar and shall be capable of being used for:

- Trenchless potholing of utilities
- Exposing/locating lines
- Manhole cleanout
- Water line cleanout

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District (District), is a political subdivision of the State of Utah and a tax exempt entity. The District provides O&M services on many large pipelines, vaults and other water conveyance features. The District has a need from time to time to dismantle and lift heavy water infrastructure and to pump out buried vaults and vacuum locate and pothole existing pipelines and utilities. The bid shall be in a sealed envelope clearly marked as a bid for "vacuum pump" on the outside.

Evaluation of Bids

Bids will be evaluated based on their responsiveness to this request and to the extent that the submitted bid meets the District's objectives, including but

not limited to: overall quality, low-maintenance requirements, function, ease of use/operation, and cost proposal.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality or technicality in a bid, and to make award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder if deemed in the best interest of the District, or public good, and subject to approval by the Board of Trustees of the District. It is anticipated that an award will be made by June 25, 2008; however bids shall be good for up to 45 days from the date submitted.
