

Fort Field Diversion Modifications – Phase 2

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the “OWNER” of the work), 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah 84058, until **2:00 PM MDT on Monday, August 24, 2009**, for furnishing plant, materials, and labor and performing all work for construction of the Fort Field Diversion Modifications – Phase 2 for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. The award, if made, will be within thirty (30) days after the opening of bids.

PRE-QUALIFICATION: Bids must include a demonstration of five years of recent experience in the general type of work to be done including listing two successfully completed similar construction projects (including: cast in place concrete, radial gates, rock work, and stream diversion permit compliance). Provide current phone numbers for the owners of both of these stream construction projects.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The construction work, in general, consists of constructing a sluicing structure and installing a 48-inch radial gate furnished by the owner, furnishing and placing large rock in the 1-2 cubic yard size, furnishing and placing stream gravel and furnishing and installing related appurtenances and miscellaneous metal work.

SITE OF WORK: The work is located at the existing Fort Field Diversion Dam on the Provo River in Utah County, Utah at the east end of the KOA campground at 320 North Geneva Road, Provo, Utah.. The construction work area is limited to the Provo River channel and three adjacent camping lots in the KOA campground. Access to the work site is through the KOA campground from Geneva Road.

COMPLETION OF WORK: Work under this contract will begin on or before the tenth day after receiving written Notice to Proceed from the Owner.

The work must be fully completed by November 30, 2009.

OPENING OF BIDS: The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud **at 2:00 PM on Monday, August 24, 2009**. Any bid received from a bidder after the closing time for receipt of bids will be returned unopened.

OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: The Contract Documents are entitled “FORT FIELD DIVERSION MODIFICATIONS – PHASE 2”.

Those interested in purchasing individual sets of Contract Documents may obtain all Contract Documents from the Construction Manager at the above address. The *non-refundable* cost for all Volumes of the Contract Documents is \$50.00.

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This Contract is for a Federally Funded Project, and the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, shall be paid for each craft or type of workman needed to perform the Contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and to the Equal Employment Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Notice Inviting Bids or any resulting contracts.

The Contractor shall complete and sign the Affirmative Action Certification as part of his bid submittal.

BID SECURITY: Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond (acceptable to the Owner), in the amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the lump sum bid amount, payable without condition to the Owner as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the Contract, will promptly execute such Contract in accordance with the Bid and in manner and form required by the Contract Documents, and will furnish good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the same. The bid securities of the three (3) lowest bidders will be retained until the Contract is signed and satisfactory bonds furnished, or other disposition made thereof. The bid securities of all bidders except the three (3) lowest will be promptly returned after the canvass of bids.

BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN: The Bidder shall guarantee the Total Bid Price for a period of sixty (60) calendar days from the date of bid opening.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT and PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A mandatory pre-bid site visit will be held on Wednesday, August 12, 2009 to field review the proposed construction area, which will include a question and answer period. This mandatory pre-bid conference will start at 2:00 pm at the Central Utah Water Conservancy District offices at 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah.

The purpose of this meeting will be to clarify the intent of the Plans and Specifications and to answer any questions bidders and/or suppliers may have on the project.

PROJECT ADMINISTRATION: All communication related to the WORK shall be directed to the Construction Manager prior to opening of Bid.
