

SPANISH FORK PROVO RESERVOIR CANAL PIPELINE - SPRINGVILLE REACH

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the "OWNER" of the work), 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah 84058, until **10:00 AM MDT on Tuesday, August 25, 2009**, for furnishing plant, materials, and labor and performing all work for construction of the Spanish Fork Provo Reservoir Canal Pipeline - SPRINGVILLE REACH for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. The award, if made, will be within thirty (30) days after the opening of bids.

AMERICA RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009: A portion of the funding for this project is provided by the America Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The selected Contractor must comply with the provisions of said act as specified in the act and in the contract documents including section 1605 of said act which requires that "...all of the iron, steel, and manufactured goods used in the project are produced in the United States."

PRE-QUALIFICATION: CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION IS REQUIRED BY THE OWNER, and only pre-qualified bidders will be allowed to submit a bid. The PRE-QUALIFICATION STATEMENT must be obtained from the Construction Manager, completed in full and submitted and evaluated and approved by the Owner before a bidder can submit a bid. All prospective Contractors will be advised at least 10 working days ahead of the bid due date if they have been approved to bid on this project. Contractors approved to bid will be requested to submit sealed bids on this project based on the final specifications.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The construction work, in general, consists of furnishing and installing the Spanish Fork Provo Reservoir Canal Pipeline - SPRINGVILLE REACH consisting of approximately 4.9 miles of 60-inch steel pipeline with welded joints, mortar lining, and tape and mortar coating; traffic control, other appurtenances and related work.

SITE OF WORK: The work is located in Utah County, Utah in the city of Springville. The pipeline originates at the end of the Spanish Fork Provo Reservoir Canal Pipeline – Mapleton Reach and extends north approximately 4.9 miles along 400 East in Springville and within the SR 89 right of way between Springville and Provo.

COMPLETION OF WORK: Work under this contract will begin on or before the tenth day after receiving written Notice to Proceed from the Owner.

The work must be fully completed by November 30, 2010.

OPENING OF BIDS: The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud **at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, August 25, 2009**. Any bid received from a bidder who is not pre-qualified or received after the closing time for receipt of bids will be returned unopened.

OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: The Contract Documents are entitled "SPANISH FORK PROVO RESERVOIR CANAL PIPELINE – SPRINGVILLE REACH".

Those interested in purchasing individual sets of Contract Documents may obtain all Contract Documents from the Construction Manager at the above address. The *non-refundable* cost for all Volumes of the Contract Documents is \$200.00.

This Contract is for a Federally Funded Project, and the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, shall be paid for each craft or type of workman needed to perform the Contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and to the Equal Employment Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Notice Inviting Bids or any resulting contracts.

The Contractor shall complete and sign the Affirmative Action Certification as part of his bid submittal.

BID SECURITY: Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond (acceptable to the Owner), in the amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the lump sum bid amount, payable without condition to the Owner as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the Contract, will promptly execute such Contract in accordance with the Bid and in manner and form required by the Contract Documents, and will furnish good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the same. The bid securities of the three (3) lowest bidders will be retained until the Contract is signed and satisfactory bonds furnished, or other disposition made thereof. The bid securities of all bidders except the three (3) lowest will be promptly returned after the canvass of bids.

BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN: The Bidder shall guarantee the Total Bid Price for a period of sixty (60) calendar days from the date of bid opening.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT and PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A **mandatory** pre-bid site visit will be held on **Wednesday, August 5, 2009** to field review the proposed construction area, which will include a question and answer period. This **mandatory** pre-bid conference will start at 10:00 am **at the Central Utah Water Conservancy District offices at 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah.**

The purpose of this meeting will be to clarify the intent of the Plans and Specifications and to answer any questions bidders and/or suppliers may have on the project. ***Only those bidders who have been pre-qualified and have attended the pre-bid conference will be allowed to submit bids.***

PROJECT ADMINISTRATION: All communication related to the WORK shall be directed to the Construction Manager prior to opening of Bid.
