Weather station, pager access, or moisture sensor kit for addition to previously purchased system \$100.00</p> <p>3. Pressure regulator for irrigation system (<b>NOT A BACKFLOW PREVENTER</b>) 50% of hardware cost. Maximum rebate \$45.00</p> <p>4. Low precipitation stream-spray nozzles, PRS (pressure reducing) heads, bubblers, xeri-sprays, xeri-pops, drip emitters or kits (please indicate drip system components on receipt), and pressure reducers for drip systems 50% of hardware cost.
